110653	6	Larry Williams calling from 21262 US RTE 68 to advise his neighbor called him and advised her husband was dead. He is in the house and the male is in bed with the female and male is dead-female is Hospice patient and is not "doing well".
110728	15	8B42 dispatched to call
110830	1	Larry Williams calling again to advise that he just saw a gun lying next to the female in the bed and he thinks she has shot herself. She called him approximately 10 mins ago to tell him her husband was dead. He just noticed the gun and asked her if she shot herself but she cannot respond. Dispatcher Henry instructs Larry to leave the residence and wait for assistance.
111023	15	Disp Ellis asks 8B42 if he has cell service
111040	15	8B42 advises affirmative on cell service-Disp Ellis requests he call her ASAP
111201	11	Call in from C/O Ellis from the Sheriff's Office to enquire if the road unit needs assistance. Dispatcher Henry advises CO Ellis that the male is DOA and female appears to be alive.
111205	12	Johnson with BCSO calling to check status of 8B42-Dispatcher Ellis informs him of call on US68 that female called our caller to adv her husband was dead and when our caller responded to the residence-he found both subj's dead. Fayetteville Squad calls in and is advised by Disp Ellis the same information she had given Johnson
111219	14	8B42 (Noble) calling-is advised by Dispatcher Henry that the female may still be viable

111504 10 Fayetteville Squad calling-advised of all correct information-they advise Fayetteville PD is in front of the station now can they just go and secure the scene-they are advised by Disp Henry we will have to have clearance from S.O. for that.

111607 9 Disp Ellis calls Det Moore (8D83)gives all details of the pending call and advises 8D83 that both subjects are dead

112050 15 8B42 requesting call-Disp Ellis gives scene address and advises INV has been contacted and 8D83 will be en route shortly

112115 11 Johnson calling again-he is advised by Disp Henry that the female is possibly viable-not dead

112147 12 8D83 calling to ask for coroner to be contacted

112246 15 8B42 marks with details on prior domestic he handled

112326 15 4D88 asks if 8B42 would like back up when he responds through?-Disp Ellis adv's that the INV unit will arrive prior to 8B42

112632 10 Disp Henry calls Coroner and advises of all information on the call

113026 15 8B24 asks for address of scene-Disp Ellis gives address-8B24 advises en route

113059 15 Disp Ellis informs 8B42 that INV asked for Coroner to be notified and call was placed

113456 15 8D83 advises en route to Fayetteville

113730 15 Christy tells 8D83 that fire chief is in front of the residence with Fayetteville PD and there may be a viable subject inside he and the PD will secure the scene and he is asking for his EMS crew to respond in-4D88 has traffic that is too broken to read

113901 15 4D88 advises he and 4D90 were in the area for a warrant location and were flagged down and asked to respond in. They advised they would not respond in without authorization- 8D83 marks and advises to have FPD and Firechief respond to check status of female

114019 9 Lt Fetters (8B70) calls Disp Ellis gives all details on the call and advises 8B70 that the female was not responding to our caller at last contact.

114024 10 Per request of 8590 call placed to Careflight to check if available

114158 15 4D88 marks advising one subject is DOA another is alive and have a selfinflicted GSW firearm has been secured

114314 11 Careflight calling to advise grounded due to weather

114403 15 8D82 advising en route Fayetteville

114446 10 PS to Clinton Memorial to advise of possible incoming patient from this scene

General Operating Guidelines

Burglary
Burglaries can be divided into two categories: burglary of a business and burglary of a residence.

Burglary involves entry into a building and commission of a crime inside, while robbery is taking property by force or threat of force. When an incident occurs while the caller is away from home, or the business is closed, it is classified as a burglary.

The caller should be instructed to remain outside and not to touch anything in order to preserve evidence. If the call is a burglary in progress the call taker should remain on the line and gather as much descriptive information as possible.

Information needed:
Always verify EXACT LOCATION, caller's name and callback number!!

- *Exact incident location?
- *Business or residential
- *In progress? Time lapse?
- *Was entry made or only attempted?
- *Has the building been checked? Could the suspects still be inside?
- *Was anyone seen leaving the area?
- *Mode and direction of travel? *Suspect(s) descriptions? Vehicle descriptions?
- *If a home invasion:
- *Any injuries?
- *Type and extent

Remember on a Burglary in Progress the suspects are still on scene, make sure your caller is at safe location and have them stay on the line.
